WESTCHESTER 2018 PING PONG PARKINSON'S TABLE TENNIS TOURNAMENT

When: Saturday, February 17

Where: Westchester Table Tennis Center, 175 Tompkins Ave., Pleasantville, NY 10570

Rules: Players must be professionally diagnosed with Parkinson's. Each player will be assigned a rating before or on the day of the tournament. The rating will reflect the degree of the player's symptoms as well as his or her skill level. Each player will start in a round robin group of three to five players, in which every player will play every other player in the group. A match consists of the best of 5 games to 11 points. USATT rules apply. The higher-rated player will be handicapped by 1 point for every 100-point difference in rating up to a maximum of 7 points per game. The two players in each group with the best records will advance to the playoffs, which will be single elimination. Best record means the most matches won, followed by (in case of a tie) most games won, then (in case of a further tie) most points won. The tournament director reserves the right to alter the format depending on the registration. The tournament will use 3-star white balls. Do not wear white clothing. The decisions of the tournament officials are final.
