

New Rules and Safety Protocols for the Westchester Table Tennis Center

Memberships

- All existing memberships will be extended by 4 months.
- If you are not ready to return to the club yet, let us know, and we'll extend your membership further.

Notes

- The club will have expanded hours: Mon.-Sat., 10 am - 11 pm; Sun., Noon - 11 pm
- A maximum of 40 players will be allowed at the club at any time.
- There will be a \$1/player surcharge for each visit, for both members and nonmembers alike, to help cover the cost of reception and cleaning (see below).
- Tournaments and special club programs (League Night, etc.) are on hold until further notice.
- Stay home if you have a cough, fever, or other symptoms of illness.

New Safety Protocols for Players

- Use hand sanitizer and/or wash your hands when you arrive. Do so again if you change tables.
- Wear a mask at all times when you're not playing.
- The side room (formerly tables #13-#18) will be mask-only at all times, even for players.
- Maintain social distancing — at least 6 feet from anyone who's not from your immediate household.
- Bring your own paddle and balls (or purchase equipment at the club).
- Do not change sides between games.
- No shaking hands after matches.
- No doubles.

New Safety Protocols for the Club

- We will limit the number of tables to 20 and space them out.
- A person at the front desk will sign you in.
- We'll provide hand sanitizer (or you may use your own).
- The restroom doors will be left open, so you don't touch them when you go in to wash.
- We will clean the tables between matches and sessions and clean the restrooms frequently.
